



ADMISSION POLICY FOR THE YEAR 2024-25

Kirloskar Institute of Management's admissions criteria seeks applicants with a high potential for success in the program and in their future employment. Kirloskar Institute of Management considers the following aspects of a candidate's profile :

Academic Eligibility

Graduates and final-year students from AIU/UGC/AICTE-accredited universities who achieve at least 50% aggregate marks (or equivalent) in the General category (45% in the SC and ST categories) are eligible to apply, according to AICTE guidelines. Students may be admitted provisionally, and they must provide proof of successful graduation by December 31, 2024 (for the current year's intake).

Entrance Examination

As per AICTE norms, KIM accepts valid scores in CAT/ XAT/ CMAT/ MAT/ ATMA/ MHCET (For Pune Campus)/ PGCET (For Harihar Campus)

Work Experience

Weightage is given to work-experience as students with work experience bring a lot of value to the PGDM program

Diversity and Inclusion

Kirloskar Institute of Management seeks a diverse student body in terms of gender, socioeconomic status, ethnicity, and professional experience. A varied cohort broadens the learning experience and prepares students for a dynamic corporate environment.

Performance in the selection process

In order to be considered, candidates must complete a case study and then face-to-face interviews with members of the academic team. Case studies are a useful tool for encouraging students to realistically apply the knowledge and abilities they have acquired to a real-world scenario. The PI panel evaluates the candidate's knowledge, attitude, analytical aptitude, communication abilities, potential for leadership, entrepreneurial spirit, and capacity for learning.



The Admission Process at Kirloskar
Institute of Management

The admission procedure at Kirloskar Institute of Management begins with the dates specified by AICTE rules. The institute's selection procedure is intended to identify individuals who have a high likelihood of using their PGDM at KIM to launch a successful career. Candidates can fill the application form online.

When the admissions office receives the completed application form, it sends a copy of the prospectus to the candidate.

Eligible candidates are shortlisted based on their academic performance (X/XII/Graduation/PG), professional qualifications, admission exam scores, sports/extracurricular activities, and job experience.

The selected students are notified via email about the next two phases in the selection process: the Case Study round and the Personal Interview (PI). Case study rounds and interviews are conducted online.

Selected candidates are notified of their selection by sending Offer Letters for admission to the program. Candidates who are not selected get a regret email. The weightages for the various components in the student's final score are as follows:

Kirloskar Institute of Management Application Form filling Steps

1. To complete the application, the candidate must go to www.kim.edu.in, our website.
2. The student will be sent to the registration page after selecting the "Apply Now" option.
3. The student must proceed with filling out the application form and completing the verification process after registering.



Offer Acceptance Fee and Withdrawal

When an applicant receives an admissions offer from KIM and accepts it within the allotted time, they must submit an offer acceptance amount with their offer acceptance. In the event that a candidate decides to withdraw the offer within the AICTE-specified withdrawal window, the offer acceptance amount will be reimbursed, less a processing charge of Rs. 1,000. Refunds will not be granted to candidates who file for withdrawal beyond the AICTE-specified deadline. If a candidate registers for the program, his/her Offer Acceptance Amount will be adjusted against Term I Fee.

Any dispute concerning admissions to the PGDM Batch 2024-26 would be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts within the territorial jurisdiction of the city of Pune, Maharashtra and Harihar, Karnataka only.
